

OUR BAGGAGE POLICY HAS CHANGED...



Everyone wants a faster, easier check-in process

So we're changing our baggage allowances to streamline the process and ensure all passengers get a fair allowance. Now, no matter where you're heading, you and your bags can get there without a fuss.

Even though we've made it easier for you to understand our policy, we still recommend that you check your eticket for your allowance before leaving home.

Air New Zealand Baggage Allowance

(for all fares purchased from 26th May 2010[†])

Our cabin baggage policies

Economy:

One carry-on bag with maximum total dimensions of 118cm (width + height + depth) and maximum weight of 7kgs. Plus one additional small personal item such as a handbag, slim line laptop, or duty free goods (where applicable).

Business Premier and Premium Economy:

Two carry-on bags with maximum total dimensions of 118cm (width + height + depth) and maximum weight of 7kgs. Plus one additional small personal item such as a handbag, slim line laptop, or duty free goods (where applicable).

- Notes:**
1. For Air New Zealand Link flights the total dimensions must not exceed 105cm.
 2. The small personal item should be stored under the seat in front.

Infants and children

Infants will be entitled to the same baggage allowance as their accompanying adult and we'll carry your strollers and car seats free of charge.

Additional allowance charges

If you want to take bags between 23kgs and 32kgs internationally, or you want to carry additional bags, there will be an extra charge. This table should clear up any questions you might have.

The prices in the table are cumulative, and need to be added together. As an example, if you travel between Auckland and Sydney with two additional bags, you'll be charged \$200: \$50 for your first additional bag and \$150 for the second.

Additional Information:

- * Flexi Plus Domestic and Works Deluxe are entitled to 2 pieces of baggage.
 - * Seat option only on short-haul international are not entitled to a free checked baggage allowance.
 - * Passengers who are Airpoints Gold and Gold Elite, Star Alliance Gold or who belong to our Koru Lounge programme are able to carry 1 additional piece up to 23kgs, up to a maximum of 3 pieces. (Koru Lounge member travelling on the Air New Zealand network only).
- ^Δ If your bag weighs more than 23kgs, we'll ask you to remove a couple of heavy items before we can put your bag through. And if you're transporting a single item that weighs more than 23kgs (like a guitar amp), we'll take it for you - but it may cost you a bit extra.
- [†] Baggage allowance for passengers who purchased their ticket before 26 May 2010 is valid for the life of your ticket. Please check your ticket for your baggage allowance.
